Board Chair acknowledged that our libraries are located on the traditional ancestral and unceded territories of the Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish), and səlílwəta?‡/Selilwitulh (Tsleil-Waututh), and xwmə0kwəyəm (Musqueam) First Nations, whose ancestors have lived here for countless generations as thoughtful and caring stewards of these lands and waters. Board chair is personally grateful for the opportunity to connect, share, and inspire on this unceded Coast Salish Territory. Board Chair welcomed guests to the meeting for the presentation later in the agenda.

Director reminded Board we are one month away from the anniversary of March 27, 2021.
 There will be a small, discreet, unpublicized ceremony to honour the victims with a tree and bench in the plaza. Board members offered to support the staff that day by being present in the Library and fielding questions/comments from the patrons to relieve staff from possible trauma triggers. Director thanked the Board for this offer and support during this time.

  increase in patron interactions around the mask mandate causing difficult interactions for

  de-escalation techniques.

The main reason for these updates is to ensure that the Library has a process in place to ensure that the personal information of library patrons is protected by regularly reviewing and destroying patron information that is no longer require. Query from Trustee about patron's rights to ask the Library to delete their information. SB confirmed that the library would respond to this request.
